Isaiah 7:10-14

* **Prophetic Passages**—in Scripture often have an immediate meaning for present-day hearers but also an added meaning for ______ generations.

Immediate: In spite of King Ahaz having false humility, God would send a sign anyway—a special child probably born in his day, but the <u>ultimate</u> in <u>the birth of Christ</u>.

Future: Matthew quotes this word for word—<u>Matthew 1:23</u> "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call Him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

King Ahaz—______ to trust Assyria, a wicked empire, rather than to trust a Loving, Almighty God.

Galatians 4:4 "When the time had fully come, God sent His Son."

Isaiah 9:6, 7

2) Mighty God—His will come "God with us", God Himself in flesh, with all the power of heaven.

3) Everlasting Father—Jesus Christ came to earth as a baby, but He always existed in eternity past.

4) Prince of Peace—This Son of the One True God will bring fulfillment, hope, and freeing peace.

* Matthew 9:35-38
