"What if Jesus had not come?" Listen to This: "I have no problem preaching to the choir. Just because they know the tune, doesn't mean they ______ the words." 1 Corinthians 2:4, 5 "And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit. I did this so you would not trust in human wisdom but in the power of God." * Matthew 1:18-25 * Truth: Following God's plan will require change in your life but it's worth it. 1. Joseph—"Faithful to The Law": A Truly Man Matthew 1:19 "Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace..." * Joseph's Godly Life—He knew God's Word (O.T.) and had a desire to please God over his own reputation: he loved Mary and did not want to disgrace her publicly. * "It's easier to _____ strong children than repair broken men." ~Frederick Douglas Joseph's Example: 1) Mary becoming pregnant thru the Holy Spirit certainly Joseph to areas of faith, growth, and courage where he had never imagined! 2) Joseph doesn't act impulsively, but rather was open to from God and His plan. * "God speaks to us in our pleasures but He shouts to us in our pain." ~C.S. Lewis 2. Following God's Plan Will Require ______ In Your Life—BUT IT'S WORTH IT * Matthew 1:20-23 ⇒ God is more interested in your character than in your comfort. Joseph's Life Now: 1) People thought he was a lying idiot; his life was a mess, and he couldn't control it. 2) Joseph paying attention to the dream from God allows God's peace to win over fear and worry. Jesus' Name & Purpose: "... you are to give Him the name Jesus, because He will save His People from their sins."

"Jesus" - same as Joshua and Jeshua in O.T.; it means "the Lord saves."

"Immanuel" - "God with us", Jesus is not only the Messiah, but He is also God, come in the flesh.

3. Joseph's Example of Obedience

* Matthew 1:24, 25

The Danger: Hearing clearly what God wants and then doing something different.

- * Joseph <u>aligned himself</u> with God's plan; not just acceptance <u>but embracing God's disruption</u>.
- * Mary and Joseph lived in harmony, both hearing God and following God; How Wise.

Eternity's Two Big Questions:

- 1) "What did you do with My Son, Jesus Christ?"
- 2) "Did you <u>fulfill the purpose</u> that <u>I put you</u> on earth for?"

Truth: To fail on these 2 questions is more than embarrassment; they both have eternal consequences.
