<u>Luke 8:15</u> "But the <u>seed on good soil</u> stands for those... who hear the Word, <u>retain it</u>, and <u>by persevering</u> <u>produce</u> a <u>crop</u>."

<u>Psalm 126:5-6</u> "Those who <u>sow in tears will reap</u> with songs of <u>joy</u>. He who goes out <u>weeping</u>, <u>carrying</u> <u>seeds to sow</u>, will return <u>with songs of joy</u>, carrying sheaves with him."

#1. Spreading Seeds—_____ Tears

Two Tendencies:

1. Secular (Without God) - surrender to feelings

2. <u>Religious</u> - _____ <u>their feelings</u> / "follow your heart"

<u>1 Kings 19:3, 4</u> "Elijah was afraid and ran for his life..." Lord, take my life..."

• Elijah puts God in a _____: God—You need to totally defeat Baal right now!"

<u>Ezekiel 36:26</u> "I will give you a <u>new heart</u> and put a <u>new spirit</u> in you; I <u>will remove</u> from you <u>your heart of</u> <u>stone</u> and <u>give you a heart of flesh</u>."

Danger: <u>1 Kings 19:10</u> "... I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty... <u>I am</u> the <u>only one left</u> and now they are trying to kill me."

Elijah's Damaged Views:

- 1. "God must destroy all Baal worship now!" [Overly optimistic]
- 2. "I'm the only one left!" [Overly pessimistic]

#2. _____ Your Tears

Consider: Does a wise, diligent farmer keep his seeds in his barn or take his huge bag of seed and just dump it in a big pile?

 \Rightarrow <u>Don't waste</u> your <u>seeds</u> - <u>Spread them</u>!

 \Rightarrow Don't waste your _____ - Invest them!

<u>2 Corinthians 4:16-18</u> "Therefore we do not lose heart... for our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us <u>an eternal glory</u> that <u>far outweighs them all</u>. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but what is unseen. For what is <u>seen is temporary</u>, but what is <u>unseen is eternal</u>."

<u>James 5:17</u> "Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. <u>Again he prayed</u>, and the <u>heaven's gave rain</u>, and the <u>earth</u> <u>produced its crops</u>." <u>James 5:7, 8</u> "<u>Be patient</u> then brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the <u>farmer waits</u> for the land to yield its valuable crop and <u>how patient</u> he is for the autumn and summer rains. <u>You too</u>, <u>be patient</u> and <u>stand firm</u>, because <u>the Lord's coming is near</u>."

1. Ground Your Tears In God's Loving ______.

<u>2 Corinthians 6:9, 10</u> "... known, yet regarded as unknown, dying, and yet we live on, beaten, and yet not killed, <u>sorrowful</u>, yet always <u>rejoicing</u>; <u>poor</u>, yet making <u>many</u> rich; <u>having nothing</u>, and <u>yet possessing</u> <u>everything</u>."

<u>2 Corinthians 12:9</u> "... <u>My grace</u> is sufficient for you, for <u>My power</u> is <u>made perfect</u> in <u>weakness</u>."

<u>Galatians 6:9</u> "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."
