Five Stages of Growth: 1. Spiritually Dead; 2. Infant; 3. Child; 4. Young Adult; 5. Parent

* Parent —> "<u>Spiritual Parent</u>" - Reinforces the making or ______ of disciples.

* Warning: All stages of discipleship are equally valuable.

Encouragement: People who <u>aren't growing</u> need to <u>get around</u> people who are <u>growing</u>!

What Does It Mean to Grow? The Core _____

Truth: As an <u>intentional disciple</u>—understands and <u>submits</u> to Gods' authority (Head), is transformed by Jesus Christ (______), and joins Jesus on His Kingdom mission (Hands) - his ______ is radically changed. (2 Timothy 2:6-8)

The Core Four

#1. Relationship With Jesus—this <u>unites</u> the <u>other 3 together</u>. But it <u>begins here</u>.

John 15:5 "I am the true vine, you are the branches... apart from Me you can do nothing."

#2. Relationship Within Gods Family the Church—As Core **#1** is real, we learn

others in Christ. (Ephesians 4:12, 13)

#3. Relationship At Home—Best place to make disciples!

<u>Ephesians 6:4</u> "Fathers, do not exasperate your children, instead <u>bring them up</u> in the <u>training</u>... <u>of the</u> <u>Lord</u>."

#4. Relationship With The World—90% of the Roman world would have been <u>considered slaves</u>.

Ephesians 6:5, 6 "Slaves, obey your earthly masters... as you would obey Christ."

The Benefits: Change isn't instantaneous, following Christ is a journey we take together, and we all need help from others to grow up in Christ.
