New Message Series: Hope – Defeating The Enemy Inside

Today's Message: The Power of Sin in What It Is

1. Sign Up: The Enemy	
Two Humbling Realities:	
1) Sin <u>living in us</u> is a "law" us, like cancer.	
Romans 7:21 "So I find this law at work: When <u>I want</u> to do good, <u>evil</u> is <u>right there with me</u> ."	
'law" - expresses the <u>power</u> , <u>authority</u> and <u>control</u> that <u>sin exercises in us</u> and <u>often wins</u> by <u>enticing</u> , <u>threatening</u> , even <u>bullying</u> each of us, <u>grabbing us by the throat</u> : Yet it's <u>is dead</u> .	
2) This " <u>law</u> " is at <u>work in</u> us even when <u>we want to do good</u> ; it trying.	
\Rightarrow Christ followers have the grace of God ruling in them—they do want to please God above all else!	
Romans 7:22 "I love God's law with all my heart."	
<u>Galatians 5:17</u> "For the sinful nature <u>desires</u> what is <u>contrary</u> to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is <u>contra</u> to the sinful nature, so that <u>you do not do what you want</u> ."	<u>ry</u>
Romans 7:14-25	
⇒ The <u>law of sin and death</u> is in a <u>constant</u> against <u>our desire</u> to <u>please God</u> .	
2. Wise Up: To What's Important	
Romans 8:2 "And because you <u>belong to Him</u> , the <u>power</u> of the <u>life-giving Spirit</u> has <u>freed you from the law</u> of <u>sin and death</u> ."	
Three Truths:	
1) In your <u>struggle</u> against sin, we must <u>tightly</u> the <u>free</u> , <u>justifying Grace of God in Christ's blood</u> .	
2) If you are to walk with God and glorify Him, you need to the <u>grace of God</u> and <u>the law of sin</u> .	i =
3) Tragically: most people live in <u>darkness</u> and <u>ignorance</u> —they give little or <u>no thought</u> to <u>their soul</u> .	
Question: What is the most <u>frustrating thing</u> about the sin in <u>your heart</u> ?	

3. Don't Give Up: Victory Is Already Ours!

<u>Hebrews 11:24-26</u> "By faith Moses… <u>chose to</u> be <u>mistreated</u> along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the <u>pleasures</u> of <u>sin</u>… He regarded <u>disgrace</u> for the sake of <u>Christ</u> as of <u>greater value</u>…"

Notice: IF Moses didn't follow sin—he would have a life of "mistreatment" and "disgrace".

"This Law of Sin" - We carry it with us; it is inbred—compelling and urging us, it's a deadly companion.

Romans 7:18 "I know that nothing good lives in me, that is my sinful nature."

Hebrews 12:1 - "easily entangles"

Here's Hope: The <u>more</u> you <u>discover</u> the <u>power</u> of <u>indwelling sin</u>, the <u>less you</u> will <u>suffer its effects</u>. <u>Jeremiah 17:9</u> "The heart is <u>deceitful</u> above <u>all things</u> and <u>desperately wicked</u>..."

4. Hope for Our Haunted Hearts

Your Heart: the mind—the will—the affections—the conscience

The Enemy's Advantage: Our "unredeemed humanness" lurks and hides; it acts like tricky birthday candles.

⇒ Luke 11:24-26 - As long as we live this work of war must go on: do not slack off here.

The Winning Happens: The <u>Holy Spirit</u> takes the Horror out of the Horror Show, for <u>He knows our hearts</u>, even if we don't.

⇒ Galatians 5:17 "The Spirit wars against the flesh."

Romans 7:25 "Thanks be to God, Who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!"
